  - **Total Investment: \$2.6 million**





  - **Total Investment: \$12.2 million**





  - **Matching Investment: \$490,000**





  - **Total Investment: \$2 million**




# Charging Ahead

  - **Total Investment: \$128,000**

- **Eastern Washington University Patterson Hall**
  - **Total Investment: \$56.1 million**



# Charging Ahead

- **New EWU Residence Hall**
  - **Total Investment: \$25 million**



# Charging Ahead

- **Cheney Middle School Replacement/Renovation**
  - **Total Investment: \$37 million**



# Cheney Transportation Network

- **Arterial Streets**
  - 13.6 miles
- **Residential Streets**
  - Asphalt Streets – 24.2 miles
  - Gravel Streets – 3.5 miles
  - Closed Streets – 0.43 miles
- **Private Streets**
  - 2.8 miles

# Arterial Street Network

- **Average Street Rating – 95**
  - **1999 to 2010: Completed 100% of Arterial Streets**
    - Improvements:
      - Road widening, new sidewalks, street restoration
      - New road construction
- **Investment of \$11.5 M**
  - **\$10.3 million in grant funding**
    - TEA 21, Enhancement, ARRA, TIB
  - **\$1 million in private match**

# Residential Street Network

- **Average Street Rating – 85**
  - **1999 to 2010: Completed 81% of Residential Streets**
    - **Improvements:**
      - **Street and Sidewalk Restoration**
- **Investment of \$4.4 M**
  - **Voters approved 4% tax on electrical and natural gas in 1998.**

# SR 904 is a Regional Issue

## Multimodal Corridor

- Spokane Transit carries ~17%
- Routes saw 645,000 annual boardings—2010
- Primary route for CSD School Busses

## Economic Corridor

- Primary route for transport
- Regional center for career/workforce training
