Travel Washington's Apple Line

- The Partners
 - Federal Transit Administration
 - Greyhound
 - Northwest Trailways
 - WSDOT
 - Link
- The Product
 - One round trip per day between Omak and Ellensburg
 - Over 28,000 riders since 2008 start



Leavenworth Amtrak Service

- The Partners
 - City of Leavenworth
 - Chelan County
 - Port of Chelan
 - WSDOT
 - Private Donations

- The Product
 - One train each way every day (6:15 a.m. Westbound, 8:45 p.m. Eastbound)
 - 8,132 riders in 2011
 - 3,337 riders in the first 5 months of 2012



Central Washington Health Shuttle

- The Partners
 - Grant Transit Authority
 - Wenatchee Valley Medical Center
 - People for People
 - WSDOT
- The Product
 - Two roundtrips each weekday
 - Stops in Moses Lake, Ephrata, Quincy to Wenatchee



Yakima/Ellensburg New Bus Service

- The Partners
 - Yakima Transit
 - HopeSource
 - WSDOT
- The Product
 - Service started late November, 2011
 - The 20,000 rider was on board in June, 2012
