

- ~10,600

# School Buses

- 10,299 statewide
  - 935 pre-1994
  - 5418 1994 to 2007
- 1275 contractor
- 1702 lift equipped

- \$422.3M (district operations)

- 6.2M on transit buses




- 90 M --- To and From School


