

RESOLUTION NO. 678

WHEREAS, Judy Boekholder, Toppenish Garden Club President, proposes to designate State Highway 22, from Milepost 0 to Milepost 4, as a Blue Star Memorial Highway;

WHEREAS, Don Whitehouse, Regional Administrator, South Central Region, Washington State Department of Transportation, supports this effort;

WHEREAS, the Toppenish City Council has passed a Resolution approving this designation;

WHEREAS, the Yakima Valley Rail & Steam Museum Association, the Toppenish Lions Club, the Toppenish Rotary Club, and the Toppenish Chamber of Commerce are all in support of this effort.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Washington State Transportation Commission recognizes this designation as a positive, community supported effort.
