Subject: Final Report - Study of Transportation Goals, Benchmarks and Ten-Year Investment Criteria and Process

At the October 7, 2005 Transportation Performance Audit Board (TPAB) meeting, after a formal Request for Proposals process, the board selected Lund Consulting and Cedar River Group to conduct a study of Transportation Goals, Benchmarks and Ten-Year Investment Criteria and Process.

This study is a combination of two separate legislative mandates - one to make recommendations regarding the modification of RCW 47.01.012, state transportation goals and benchmarks, and the other to conduct a review of the comprehensive ten-year investment program process, including the required criteria.

Since both of these studies focused on legislation which mandated criteria, priorities and goals related to transportation, the board chose to combine them into a single study in order to facilitate the creation of a coherent system.
