Proposed Decision Timeline

- **January 2018:** Full Commission reviews Tolling Subcommittee recommendations and initiates rule-making process (CR-101).

January - April 2018: Commission seeks additional analysis and input for proposed rule.

- **April 2018:** Commission approves proposed rule for public input (CR-102).

April – July 2018: Commission seeks public input on proposed rule.

- **July 2018:** Public hearing and adoption of final rule (CR-103)
