- Funding overall – great success with TIB, Complete Streets and STBG grants!

## TRANSPORTATION CHALLENGES

## OPPORTUNITIES/NEEDS;

- Hoping to reclassify portion Saratoga Rd as major collector given heavy use
- Need better multimodal connections (first/last mile) into town center
- Parking limitations
- Lack funding mechanism for EV infrastructure (lack high speed charging)
- Pedestrian improvements – sidewalks and trails
- Improved ferry connectivity – auto, freight, foot
- Regional AIRPARK connectivity
