
# TOWN OF COUPEVILLE

- Population of 1,900
- Town limits are one square mile
- One mile of shoreline
- Annual operating budget of \$4 million (w/o grant projects)
- 12 full time, 2 part time, 2 police officers
- Tourism, Island County Hospital, Island County Campus, courthouse, jail, Coupeville School District. Population more than doubles during the week creating traffic and service needs.

# COUPEVILLE FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

- Looking for, finding and managing grant opportunities with a small staff.
  - Investigate Complete Street program opportunities.
  - Take better advantage of STBG funding, especially for transportation alternatives.
  - Working in partnership with County to reclassify Terry Road for IRTPO funds.

# TRANSPORTATION OPPORTUNITIES

- ADA funding, requirements change all the time, compliance is expensive.
  - EV charging station - funding and regional plan needed.
  - Commercial vehicles traveling through Coupeville on South Main from Coupeville ferry. Passes through business district and three school zones.
  - Pedestrian safety at Broadway and Hwy 20
  - Unstable bluffs will effect streets/trails in downtown Coupeville
  - Sidewalk funding needed – gravel paths developed as an alternative in Coupeville

## SLOPE STABILIZATION

- Front Street experiencing sluffing
- Closed pedestrian path
- Converted to one-way
- Without major stabilization at foot of the bluff, sluffing will continue
- Making plans to move the high pressure sewer line from this street
- Anchoring is too cost prohibitive to save the bluff and street





## GRAVEL PEDESTRIAN PATHS

Town installed gravel pedestrian paths in place of traditional cement sidewalks
