2022 Legislative Update

- 2022 is a “short” 60-day session
- Themes:
 - Climate Commitment Act (CCA)
 - Addressing the on-going impacts of the pandemic including shortfall in the transportation revenue forecast
 - Setting priorities for new federal funding
- Key issues:
 - Funding relief for key megaprojects
 - Maintenance and preservation needs
 - The ferry system
