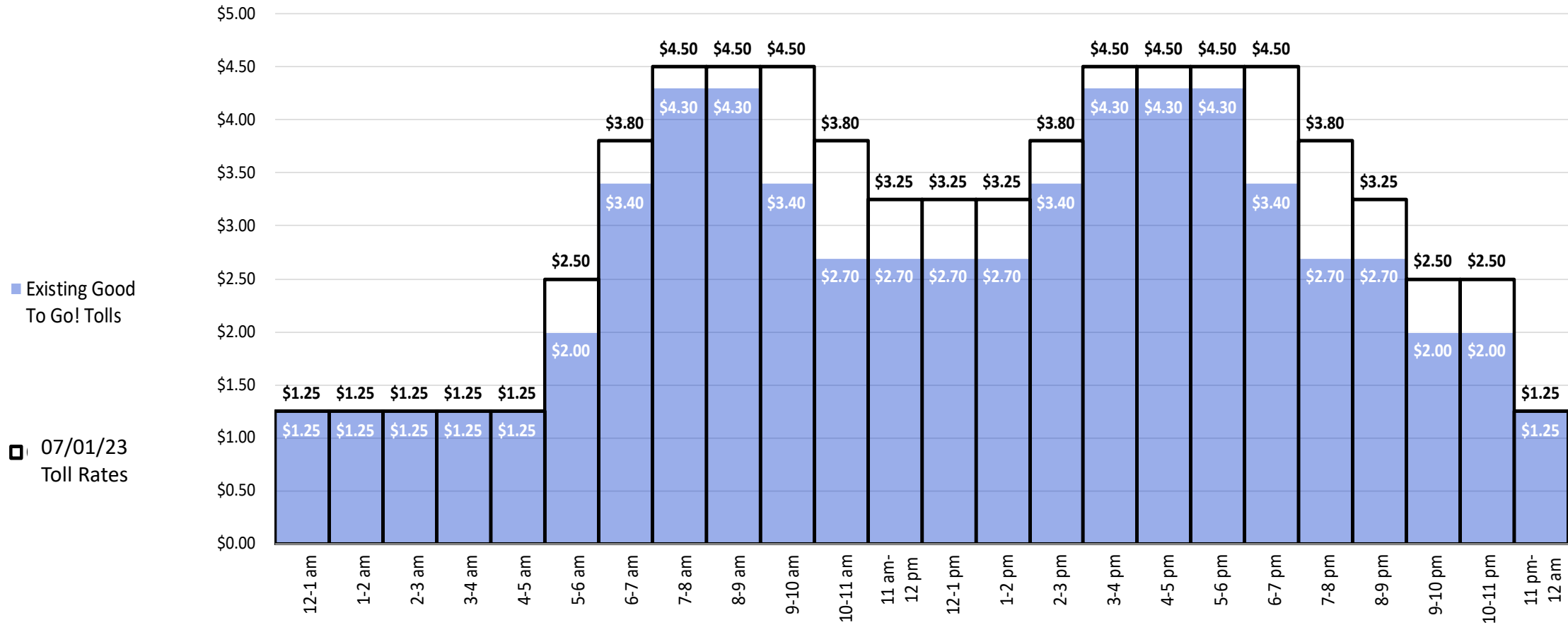

SR 520 Bridge Toll Rate Increase

- Tailored increase by time period **averaging 15% -- effective July 1, 2023**
 - Expands morning and afternoon peak periods by one hour
 - No increase in minimum toll; holds maximum toll increase to +5%
 - Increase in midday, evening, and weekend toll rates
- WSTC implemented toll rate increase in August 2021 with deferred effective date
 - Action taken in Summer 2021 to demonstrate that SR 520 net toll revenues would be sufficient to meet all forecast horizon financial obligations
 - Deferral enabled by Legislature's one-time appropriation of up to \$60 million in Federal ARPA funds in the 2021-23 biennium for operations & maintenance

SR 520 Bridge: Weekday Toll Schedule

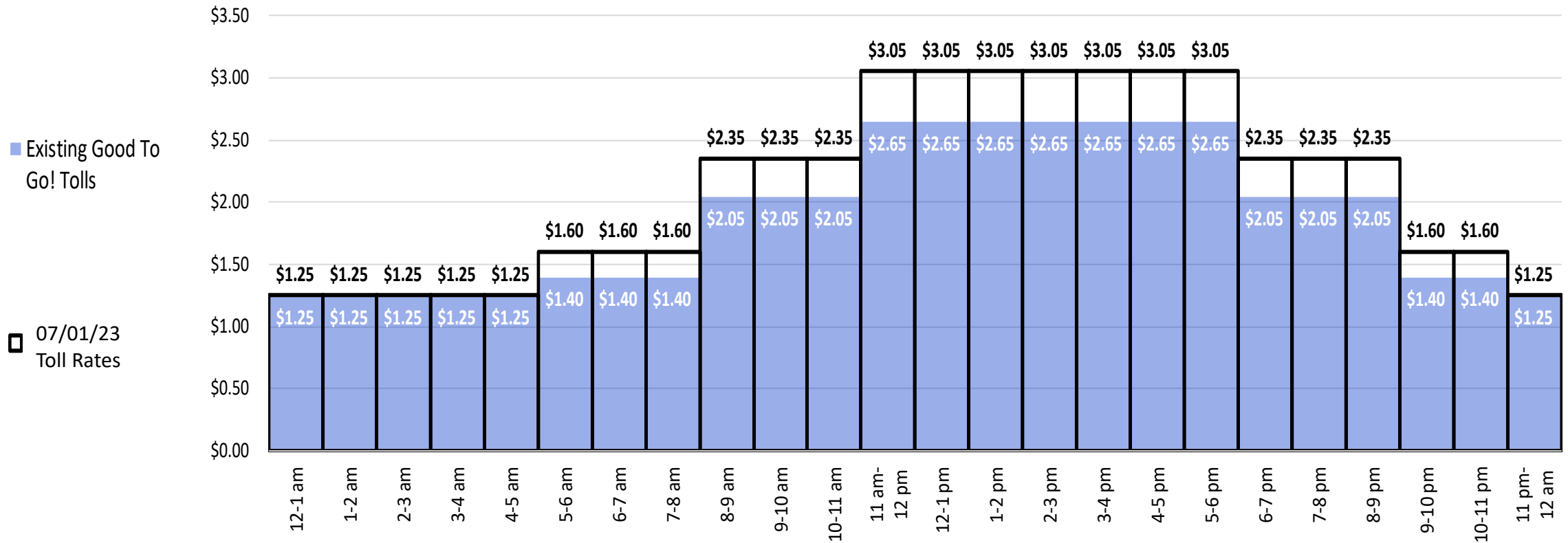
Toll Rate Increase Effective July 1, 2023
