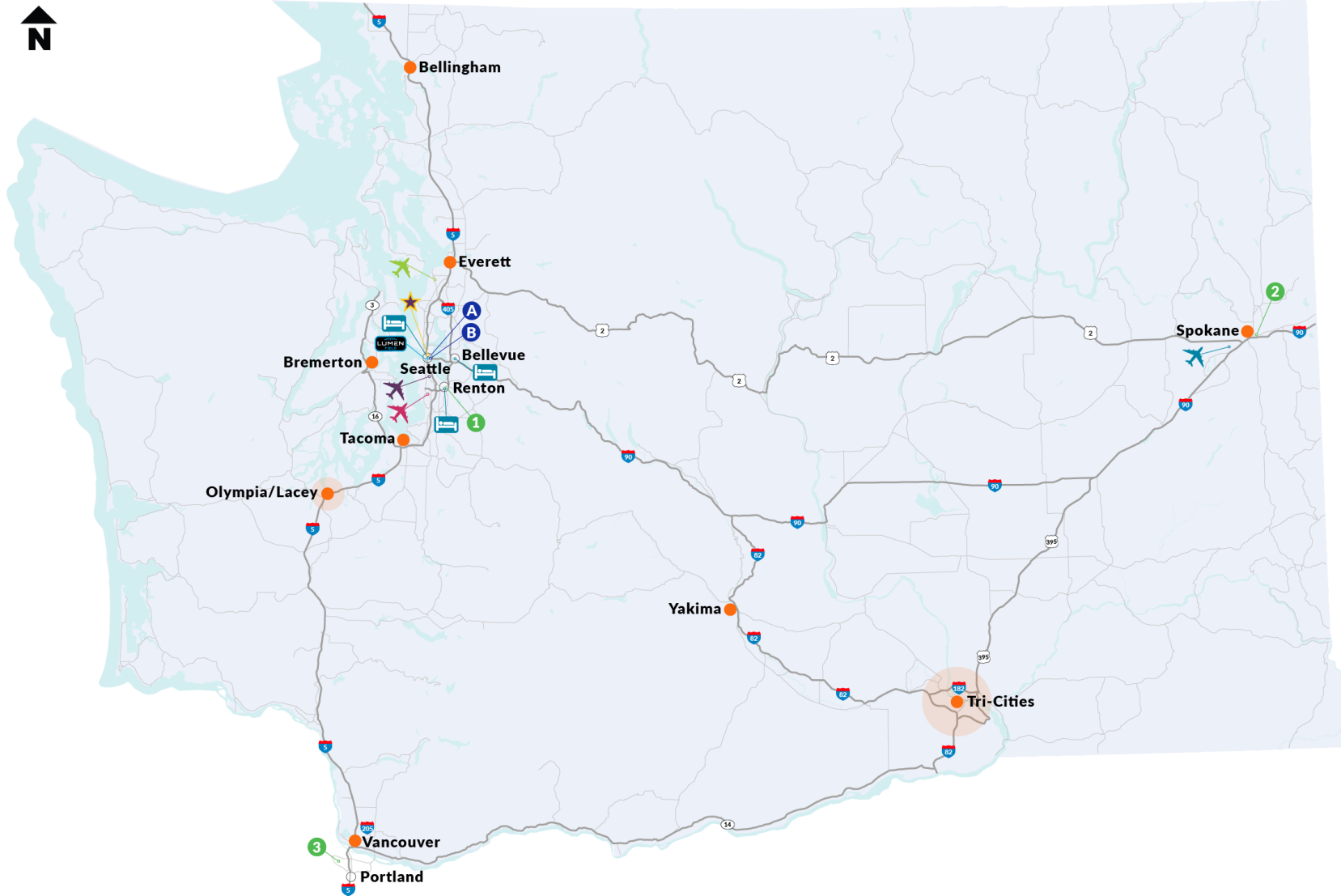

- Ensuring staff is prepared with trainings and exercises ahead of World Cup



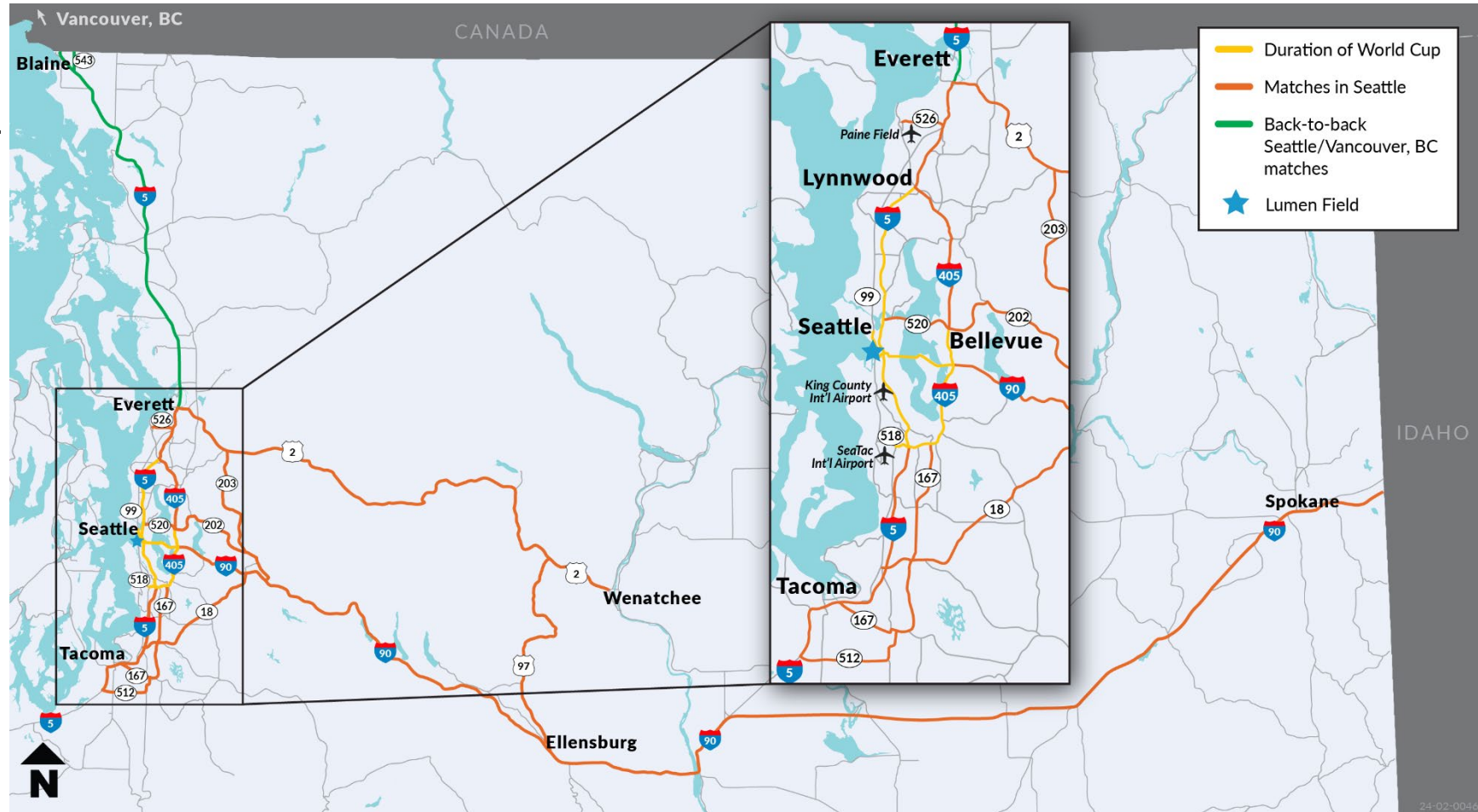
Construction and maintenance during World Cup

No overnight or weekend-long directional or full roadway closures. Typical overnight lane and ramp closures allowed.

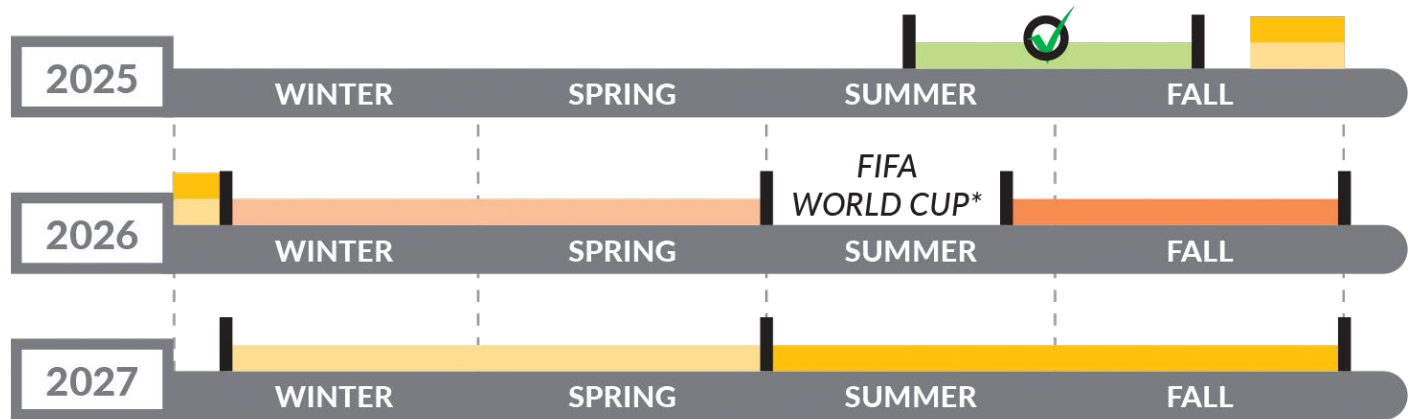
Duration of World Cup in Seattle
June 11-July 6

Matches in Seattle
From noon the day before through noon the day after scheduled matches in Seattle

Back-to-back Seattle/Vancouver, BC matches
From noon the day before the first back-to-back match until noon the day after the second match

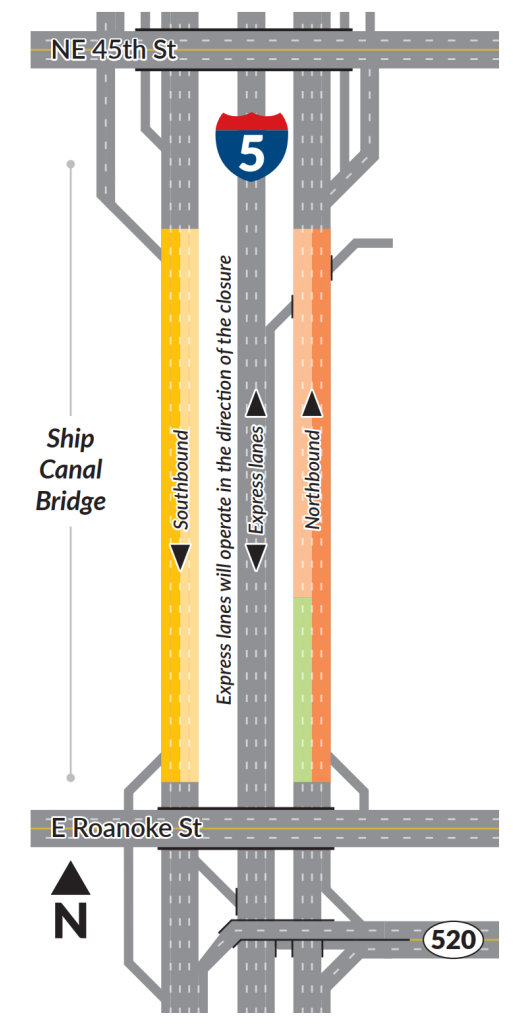


Construction and maintenance during World Cup: Revive I-5



- █ Tentative I-5 weekend-long full directional closure, weather permitting
- █ Double-lane work zone on northbound I-5 from SR 520 to Northeast 45th Street
- █ Double-lane work zone on northbound I-5 from SR 520 to Northeast 45th Street
- █ Double-lane work zone on southbound I-5 from Northeast 45th Street to SR 520
